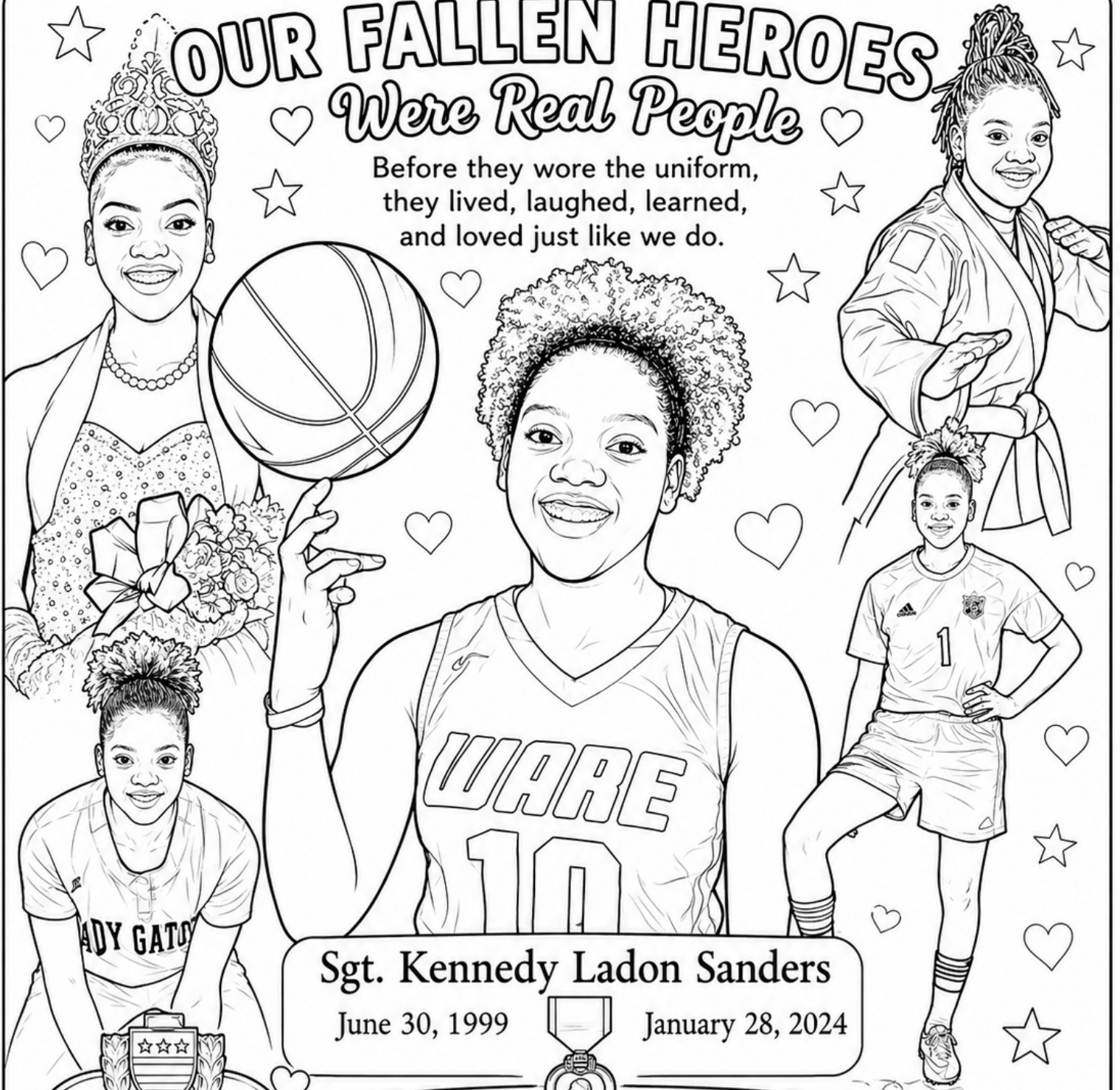

The Battlefield Cross is a powerful symbol that honors fallen heroes. It represents the ultimate sacrifice made by brave service members who gave their lives for our freedom.

WHAT EACH PART REPRESENTS:

HELMET

RIFLE

Represents the soldier and their willingness to defend our country.

DOG TAGS

Represent the soldier's identity and the bond they share with others.

BOOTS

Represent the soldier's journey and the ground they walked to serve our country.

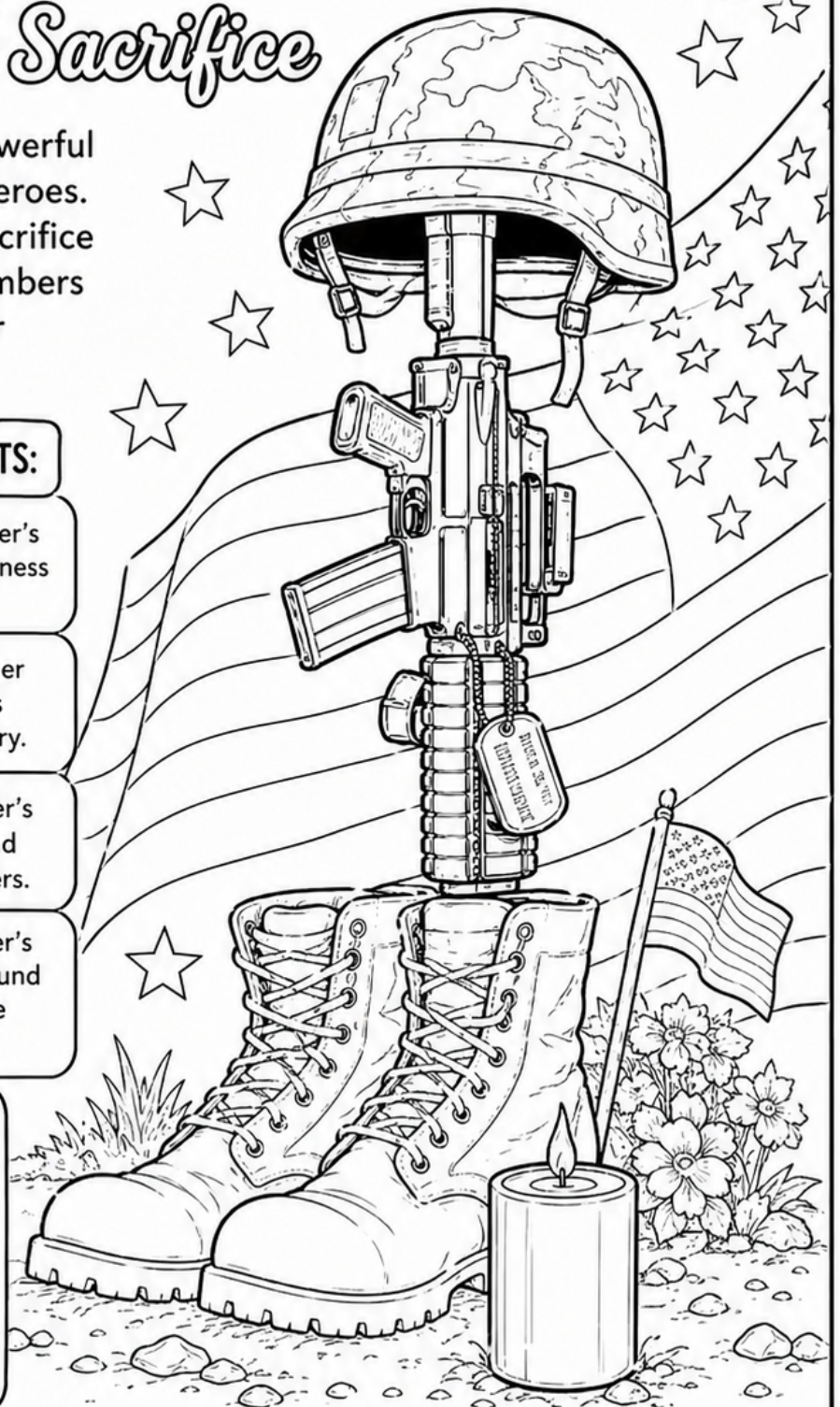

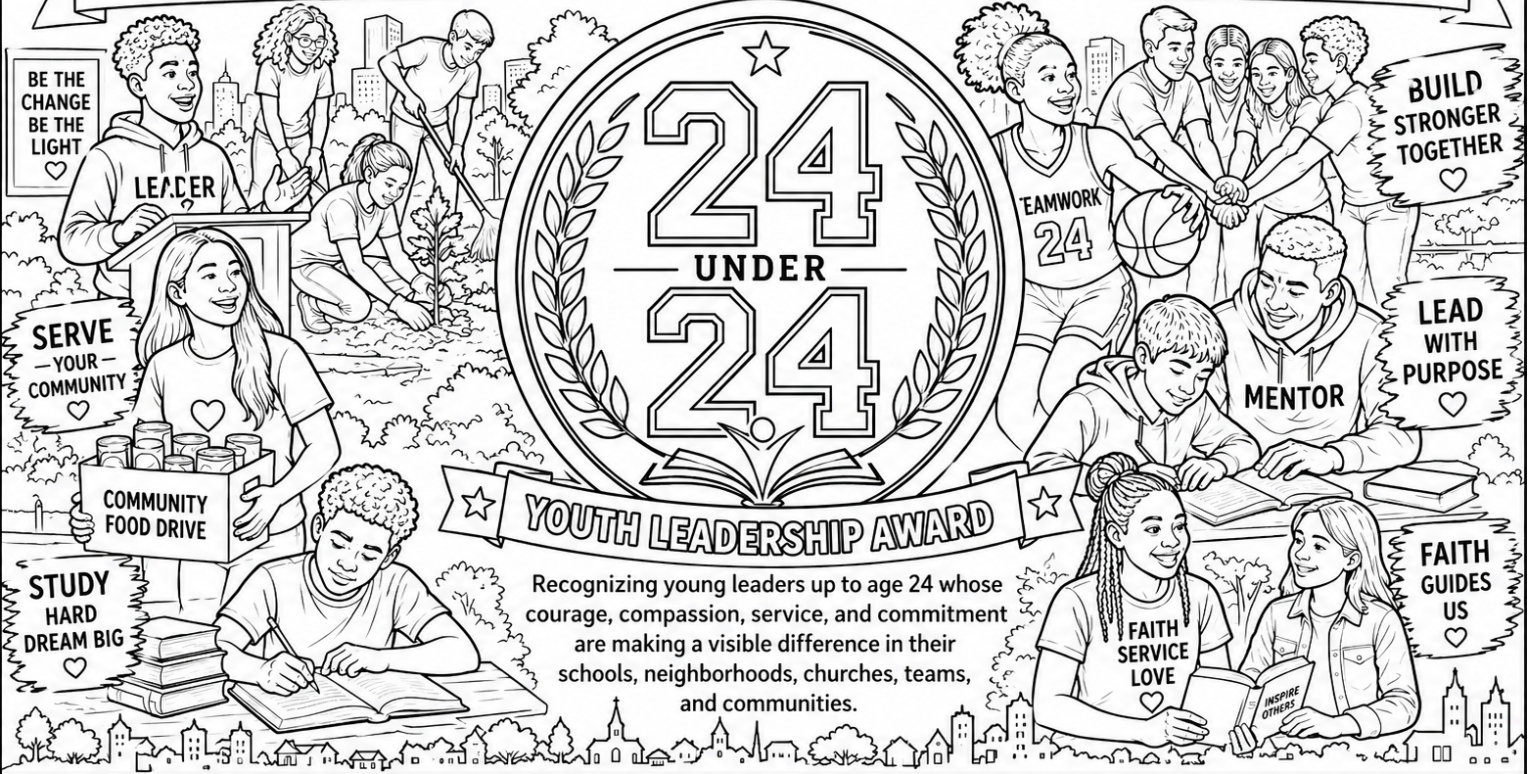
